Public Improvements – New Concrete Access Ramps, Curb and Gutter, Crosswalks

Fiscal Year 2021- C Pavement Maintenance (Concrete Improvements) Project

Beginning Monday, April 12, Onyx Paving Company, Inc. will perform concrete sidewalk improvements and construction of new sidewalk access ramps as part of the FY21C Pavement Maintenance (Concrete Improvements) Project. The concrete improvements are being done in preparation of the upcoming annual pavement maintenance (slurry seal treatment and grind and overlay work).

The first phase of the project is focused in the Oak Park Neighborhood and is expected to last approximately 5 weeks with completion in mid - May.

Detours in the surrounding areas may be in effect as needed to minimize construction duration and ensure the least disruption to normal traffic flow. Traffic control and temporary delays should be expected in the area including at the intersection of Bath and Los Olivos and cross-streets. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses, although temporary disruptions should be anticipated.

No parking signs will be posted at least 72 hours prior to construction and detour signs (as necessary) will also be provided. Work will occur Monday through Friday between 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The City has contracted with Onyx Paving Company, Inc. to perform the work, which is funded primarily by Measure C. For more information about your local sales tax at work, visit www.SantaBarbaraCA.gov/MeasureC.
