Public Improvements – New Concrete Access Ramps, Curb and Gutter, Crosswalks

Fiscal Year 2021- C Pavement Maintenance (Concrete Improvements) Project

Beginning Wednesday, June 9, Onyx Paving Company, Inc. (Onyx) will perform concrete sidewalk improvements and construction of new sidewalk access ramps in the Hidden Valley Neighborhood as the second phase of the FY21C Pavement Maintenance (Concrete Improvements) Project. The concrete improvements are being done in preparation of the upcoming annual pavement maintenance (slurry seal treatment and grind and overlay work).

The second phase of work is expected to last approximately 4 weeks with completion anticipated in the first half of July.

Traffic control will be in place and potential delays should be expected in the area. Detours in the surrounding areas may be in effect as needed to minimize construction duration and ensure the least disruption to normal traffic flow. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses, although temporary disruptions should be anticipated.

No parking signs will be posted at least 72 hours prior to construction and detour signs (as necessary) will also be provided. Work will occur Monday through Friday between 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
