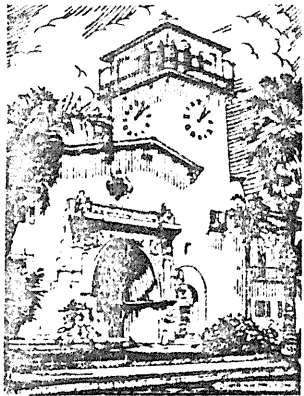

1 RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
2 COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

4 IN THE MATTER OF A PROCLAMATION) RESOLUTION NO. 75-375
5 OF THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL)
6 EMERGENCY AND RATIFYING REQUEST)
7 TO THE GOVERNOR TO DECLARE A STATE)
8 OF EMERGENCY)

9 WHEREAS, Government Code Section 8630 authorizes the
10 Board of Supervisors to declare the existence of a local emergency
11 caused by conditions of disaster or extreme peril to the safety of
12 persons and property within the territorial limits of the County;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, substantially all of the Santa Barbara County
15 Fire Department personnel are on strike and the 15 County fire
16 stations are presently not manned; and

17 WHEREAS, the president of Santa Barbara County Fire
18 Fighters Local 2046 has publicly stated that he and other Santa
19 Barbara Fire Department personnel will not answer emergency calls;
20 and

21 WHEREAS, the County is still willing to meet and confer
22 with representatives of the personnel of the Santa Barbara County
23 Fire Department concerning wages and other work-related benefits;
24 and

25 WHEREAS, the failure of Santa Barbara County fire
26 fighting personnel to respond to emergencies in the event of a
27 conflagration or other emergency will substantially impair and
28 harm the life, health and welfare of the citizens of Santa Barbara
29 County; and

30 WHEREAS, the County is in desperate need of personnel
31 and equipment to man the fire stations; and

WHEREAS, the County is presently relying only upon the
mutual aid agreements with other local governmental agencies for

1 WHEREAS, the County is relying upon the State Forestry
2 Service for watershed protection; and

3 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors does hereby find that
4 the aforementioned condition of extreme peril demands and neces-
5 sitates this proclamation of a local emergency;

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, FOUND
7 AND ORDERED as follows:

8 1. The proclamation of the existence of a local emergency
9 is hereby proclaimed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
10 Santa Barbara.

11 2. The County Administrative Officer is authorized to
12 request the Governor of the State of California and the Director
13 of the State Office of Emergency Services to proclaim a state of
14 emergency within the County of Santa Barbara.

15 3. The Administrative Officer and the County Fire
16 Chief are hereby designated as authorized representatives for
17 the purposes of receiving and processing all available state and
18 federal assistance in this time of emergency.

19 4. The Clerk of this Board is authorized and directed
20 to forward this Resolution to the Governor of the State of
21 California and the Director of the State Office of Emergency
22 Services with all possible speed.

23 5. It is understood by the Board of Supervisors that
24 all actual costs incurred for the State of California in rendering
25 services shall be reimbursed to the State.
