



# CABRILLO BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

## **Project Update: November 2016**

The new bridge girders that horizontally support the bridge deck have been placed. Crews will be ready to pour the bridge deck on Thursday, November 3rd (weather permitting).

## **Upcoming Work:**

Starting at 4:00 am on Thursday, November 3rd (weather permitting), crews will close Cabrillo Boulevard for two hours between State and Anacapa Streets to move concrete safety barrier in preparation for the concrete bridge deck pour. At 6:00 am the eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard lane will reopen shifted toward the sidewalk. The westbound Cabrillo Boulevard lane will remain closed between Anacapa and State Streets until 4:00 pm for the concrete pour. During the closures, a detour will be in place along Anacapa, Yanonali, and State Streets. Helena Avenue will be open when the eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard lane is open with left-turn only access onto Cabrillo Boulevard. The lane closure will allow crews and large trucks access to the entire width of the new beach-side of the bridge for the concrete deck pour.

Throughout November, crews will begin relocating utilities and then install new sidewalks and bridge barrier rails. Downstream creek bank improvements will be ongoing.

**Closures:**

Throughout Stage 3, the beach-side of Cabrillo Boulevard will remain closed near the bridge. One lane in each direction remains open during daytime construction on the new mountain-side of the bridge.

To accommodate the work area, the left turns from Cabrillo Boulevard to Stearns Wharf (westbound) and on to Helena Avenue (eastbound) are prohibited. Businesses on Helena Avenue remain open with both pedestrian access and vehicle access from westbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Motorists can enter Stearns Wharf from State Street and eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Detour signs are in place to highlight access around the closures.

**Fall 2014 - Spring 2017:**

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
