



CABRILLO BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Project Update: January 2017

Crews have poured the large sidewalk and one of the pedestrian barriers on the bridge. Utility relocations are ongoing.

Upcoming Work:

Utility relocations, including a large gas line, continue throughout the month. To tie in the gas line relocation, SoCalGas contractors may need to work at night within the existing project area.

Crews will also continue pouring the multipurpose paths and finish up the bridge rail improvements. Downstream creek bank improvements are ongoing.



Based on the City Council decision in November, engineers and planners are also working on plans and permits to incorporate the pedestrian bridge installed during construction into the final layouts for the multipurpose pathways.

Closures:

Throughout Stage 3, the beach-side of Cabrillo Boulevard will remain closed near the bridge. One lane in each direction remains open during daytime construction on the new mountain-side of the bridge.

To accommodate the work area, the left turn from Cabrillo Boulevard to Stearns Wharf (westbound) is prohibited. Motorists can enter Stearns Wharf from State Street and eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Detour signs are in place to highlight access around the closure.

Fall 2014 - Spring 2017:

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
