



# CABRILLO BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

**Project Update: February 2017**

Crews continue concrete work on pedestrian portions of the new bridge. Utility relocations are ongoing.

**Upcoming Work:**

Utility relocations, including a large gas line, will continue throughout the month. To expedite progress, crews will work from 5:00 am to 8:00 pm on February 9th. Noise restrictions will be in place during the early morning hours.

Later in the month, crews will focus on street improvements. After roadway work, portions of the concrete safety barrier will be moved and additional Cabrillo Boulevard lanes will reopen later this spring.

Work will also finish up on the bridge rail improvements. Downstream creek bank improvements are ongoing.

**Closures:**

Throughout Stage 3, the beach-side of Cabrillo Boulevard will remain closed near the bridge. One lane in each direction remains open during daytime construction on the new mountain-side of the bridge.

To accommodate the work area, the left turn from Cabrillo Boulevard to Stearns Wharf (westbound) is prohibited. Motorists can enter Stearns Wharf from State Street and eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Detour signs are in place to highlight access around the closure.

**Fall 2014 - Spring 2017:**

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
