



# CABRILLO BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

## **Project Update: March 2017**

Crews have finished concrete work on the pedestrian areas of the new beach-side of the Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge. The majority of utility relocations are complete. The remainder of work will focus on street and sidewalk improvements leading up to the bridge.

## **Upcoming Work:**

Crews will build new roadway and sidewalk improvements between State and Anacapa Streets. During work, pedestrians will be detoured around the southeast corner of State Street and Cabrillo Boulevard and the crosswalk will be closed at Anacapa Street. Some Arts & Crafts Show booths will be relocated in the park area during sidewalk work, so please look for your favorite artists in new temporary locations during this time.

**\*\*From March 6th through the end of the month, right turns will be prohibited from Stearns Wharf onto eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard to safely allow construction in this area.\*\***

After roadway work, portions of the concrete safety barrier will be moved and additional Cabrillo Boulevard lanes will reopen next month.

Additionally, lighting connections and a new right turn signal from Stearns Wharf will be installed.

## **Temporary Pedestrian Bridge Update:**

The temporary pedestrian bridge will be removed later this spring after the new Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge and updated pathways are open. It was hoped that the bridge could stay for an extended period of time, however the recent storms have impacted the area more than anticipated.



**Closures:**

Throughout Stage 3, the beach-side of Cabrillo Boulevard will remain closed near the bridge. One lane in each direction remains open during daytime construction on the new mountain-side of the bridge.

To accommodate the work area, the left turn from Cabrillo Boulevard to Stearns Wharf (westbound) is prohibited. Motorists can enter Stearns Wharf from State Street and eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Detour signs are in place to highlight access around the closure. Starting March 6th, right turns will not be allowed from Stearns Wharf onto eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard to safely allow construction in this area.

**Fall 2014 - Spring 2017:**

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
