



# CABRILLO BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

## **Project Update: May 2017**

Recent Progress: Cabrillo Boulevard sidewalk improvements east of Anacapa Street are complete, and the crosswalk is open at the intersection. Utility relocations are wrapping up, and roadway improvements have been installed to prepare for final paving.

## **Upcoming Work:**

On the nights of Sunday, April 30th and Monday, May 1st, crews will prepare for and then slurry seal Cabrillo Boulevard between Chapala and Garden Streets. Cabrillo Boulevard will be closed from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am each night and on-street parking will not be available. Please use detours on Garden, Yanonali, Montecito, and Castillo Streets during this time. Local traffic access will be maintained. Stearns Wharf will be closed to vehicular access on Monday night, May 1st, starting at 10:00 pm.

On Tuesday morning, May 2nd, new lanes will open on Cabrillo Boulevard with two westbound lanes, one westbound left turn lane onto Stearns Wharf, and one eastbound lane. This lane configuration will remain in place until the end of the project.

After paving, crews will finish up water main relocations. The reclaimed water system will be turned off during this work, and certain public restrooms will be closed with portable restrooms available for use.

Throughout the month of May, work will progress on sidewalks, crosswalks, the final lane striping for Cabrillo Boulevard, and electrical work.



**Closures:**

Beginning May 2nd, Cabrillo Boulevard will have two westbound lanes, one westbound left turn lane onto Stearns Wharf, and one eastbound lane open. One eastbound lane, the southerly sidewalk, and beach path across the bridge will remain closed while work is completed in the park.

**Fall 2014 - Summer 2017:**

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
