



CABRILLO BOULEVARD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

Project Update: mid-May - June 2017

Recent Progress: Paving and striping are now complete for all lanes on Cabrillo Boulevard. Earlier today, Crews opened the entire roadway and the new beachside sidewalk.



Upcoming Work:

Crews will finish up water main relocations. The reclaimed water system will be turned off during this work, and certain public restrooms will be closed with portable restrooms available for use. The beachway will have intermittent closures as needed.

Throughout the month of June, work will progress on removal of the temporary pedestrian bridge, beach pathway reconstruction, and landscaping. Please expect intermittent, temporary lane and parking closures for construction and equipment access.

Fall 2014 - Summer 2017:

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
