**City Street Pavement Maintenance Project (Zone 6)
Pavement Preparation and Slurry Seal Projects**

July 2013 — The City of Santa Barbara, Public Works Department, will begin annual street pavement maintenance in your neighborhood this summer and fall. The pavement maintenance will be conducted Monday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The project begins July 8, 2013, and will last approximately two weeks; a City contractor will be making spot repairs and asphalt overlay. Specifically, Alameda Padre Serra, from Salinas Street to Camino Viejo, and Alston Road to the City boundary will undergo spot repairs, including part of Eucalyptus Hill Road. On Barker Pass, from Eucalyptus Hill Road to the City boundary, an asphalt overlay will be applied.

The areas that require spot repairs will be sealed with slurry during the months of September – November 2013.

Contractors will provide you with advance notice of the specific dates for pavement maintenance activities on each street at least 72 hours prior to the repair work. “No Parking” signs will be posted simultaneously. There will be no road closures during construction.
