



## CALTRANS ROAD IMPROVEMENTS BEGIN ON STATE ROUTE 192

A project to grind and resurface State Route 192 from the Junction with State Route 154 to just east of Tye Road began on Monday, April 21, 2014. This project also includes the replacement of detector loops at signalized intersections.

Motorists will encounter one-way reversing traffic control in half-mile increments from 8:30 am to 4 pm Monday through Thursday and from 8:30 am to 1 pm on Fridays. Motorists can expect delays not to exceed 10 minutes and electronic message boards will be activated to inform the public about this project. This project is expected to be completed in June 2014.
