Insurance: *Mobile Operators must provide an Original Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 in General Liability Insurance naming the City of Santa Barbara as an additional insured for all operations at the Santa Barbara Airport. Operators intending to drive vehicles on the airfield, must also provide \$1,000,000 in automobile insurance. (Flight instructors who teach in non-owned aircraft are exempt from this requirement.)*

Fees: *For the privilege of operating at the Santa Barbara Airport, Operator shall pay a fee to the Airport according to the following schedule:*

Flight Instruction	\$150 annually, due and payable upon the commencement date of this Permit.
Mechanic	\$250 annually, due and payable upon the commencement date of this Permit.
Airplane Washing	\$150 monthly, due and payable upon the commencement date of this Permit and on the first day of each month thereafter.
