RFQ/P Heading – Selection Process and Criteria

Delete Item 5, Willingness and ability of the Consultant to enter into an agreement with the City using the standard City of Santa Barbara Service Agreement with contractors (Attachment 2), without modifications or supplements to the standard conditions (10 points out of 100).

Adjust total available points from 100 to 90 due to elimination of Item 5 above.

Contract for Consultant Services

Replace with the following:

At the conclusion of the selection process, the City will enter into negotiations for the design phase of the program with the Consultant receiving the highest evaluation rating. The Consultant will be required to obtain a business license from the City prior to the execution of the contract with the City, for the consulting services.

Attachment 1 – Santa Barbara City Agreement – Sample

Paragraph 8 – Defense, Indemnity, and Hold Harmless

This Paragraph may be changed if it is determined by the City that the terms are inconsistent with FAA requirements.
