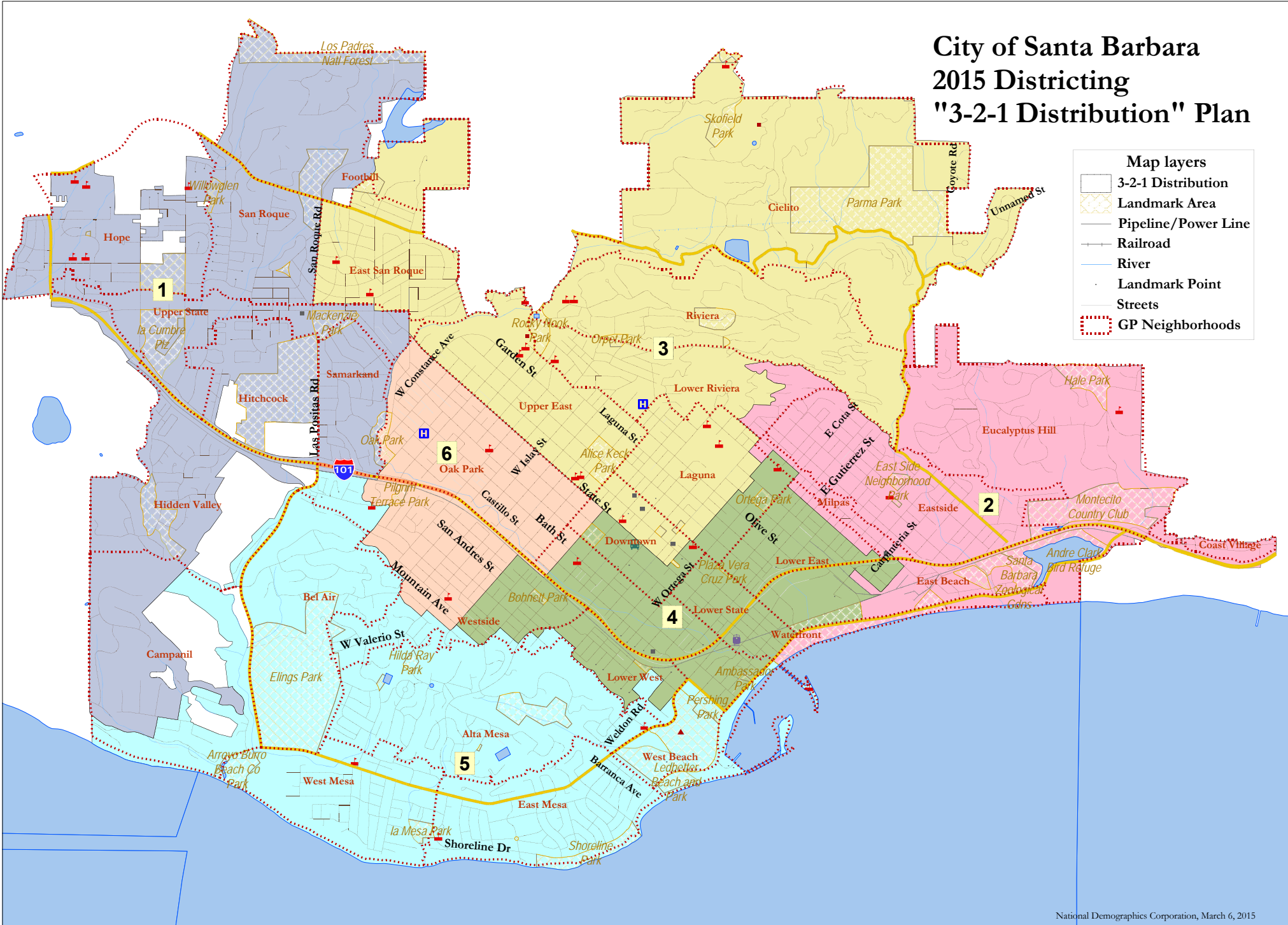


City of Santa Barbara 2015 Districting "3-2-1 Distribution" Plan
