Pre-Construction Notice**

Traffic Signal Installation at Arrellaga and De La Vina Streets

February 2015 – The Public Works Department will begin installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of Arrellaga and De La Vina streets beginning March 30, 2015.

Construction activities will be between the hours 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with an intermittent road closure and a detour at the 1600 block of De La Vina Street between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. Construction will be completed no later than mid-May 2015.

As part of the project, a left hand turn lane will be created for westbound Arrellaga Street which will necessitate extending the red curb. This will eliminate some parking spaces on Arrellaga Street, east of the intersection. One month after the traffic signal has been turned on, and drivers are used to the change, much of the red curb north of the intersection on De La Vina Street will be removed, which will compensate for the lost parking on Arrellaga Street.

In 2013, this intersection had 12 collisions, the highest of any intersection in Santa Barbara. This project will improve traffic safety. To minimize the impact to traffic flow on De La Vina Street, the traffic signal will be synchronized with the signal at De La Vina Street and Micheltorena Street.
