



PROJECT TITLE: De La Guerra Street Bridge Over Mission Creek Replacement Project

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The project will involve replacement of the existing structurally deficient bridge with a new structure, which will also improve the hydraulic conveyance of Lower Mission Creek, as discussed in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Lower Mission Creek Environmental Impact Report/ Environmental Impact Study.



PROJECT BENEFITS:

The replacement bridge will be constructed in accordance with requirements of the federal-aid Highway Bridge Program, Environmental Permits, current American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials, and local standards. The new bridge will be designed to accommodate the planned Santa Barbara County Flood Control creek widening improvement project. Additional lighting will be added near the new bridge, along with non-invasive native riparian plantings.
