The Work Trip Incentive Program (WorkTRIP)

The City offers a generous Transportation Demand Management Program called the Work Trip Reduction Incentive Program (WorkTRIP). By encouraging our staff to leave their cars at home, we help preserve air quality, decrease traffic congestion, conserve fuel, and promote better health for our employees and our residents.



WorkTRIP offers the following active or alternative transportation incentives for City Employees:

- The use of a City vehicle for registered carpools
- Free MTD passes for in-town trips
- Free annual bike tune ups
- Discounted BCycle Santa Barbara annual bike share memberships
- 75% transit subsidies (or reimbursements) for Amtrak Surfliner, Coastal Express, Valley Express and Clean Air Express riders
- Use of regular and pedal-assist e-bikes for personal and work trips (located at Downtown Parking, City Hall, and 630 Garden St)
- Registered WorkTRIP participants who use active or alternative transportation may use a City fleet car for personal trips during the day
- Guaranteed Ride Home with City fleet vehicles or SBCAG's Emergency Ride Home Program
- Free secure bicycle parking at the Bike Spot at Granada Garage
