## Thawing and Freezing Holds in Aspen

Navigate to the Aspen catalog, available on the library website: https://catalog.sbplibrary.org/

If you are not already logged into Aspen, you will be prompted to enter your library card number and PIN in a pop up window. Remember, your PIN is typically the last 4 digits of your phone number.

Click on the white box to view your holds.



You have several options to modify your holds in Aspen:

*Cancel hold* will cancel your hold. You should only use this option if you no longer wish to request an item.

Change pickup location allows you to change your pickup location to a different SBPL branch.



*Thawing your hold* means that your inactive hold will become active again. You should use this option when you are ready for your hold.
